Are your projects truly accommodating for all? Are you trying to get children with disabilities in school, but are not sure how to do it? Do you have trouble making inclusive projects financially sustainable? Do you find it difficult to anchor inclusion in the policy of your organisation? Have you been involved in a successful project and would like to share your experiences? Do have some strong opinions on inclusion based on your expertise?

Then join the **Open Up! Workshop** to share your questions and doubts *and* your tips and tools on inclusive education. It is aimed at both programme officers who are experts *and* those who wish to learn more about inclusion in development and emergency situations. And at anyone who is concerned about this theme.
